- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 Sec. 1. (1) The dispute resolution center study NEW SECTION. 5 commission is created to consist of seven members as follows: (a) Two members of the senate law and justice committee, one from each of the 6 major caucuses, who are appointed by the secretary of the senate; (b) two members of the house of representatives law and justice committee, 8 one from each of the major caucuses, who are appointed by the speaker 9 10 of the house of representatives; (c) a court administrator; (d) a director of a dispute resolution center; and (e) one representative of 11 12 the collection industry, appointed by the governor. The administrator 13 for the courts shall provide for the staffing and expenses of the 14 commission.
  - (2) The dispute resolution center study commission shall review the current method for funding dispute resolution centers and study alternative methods for providing such funding, including use of alternative funding sources. The commission shall submit a written report of its findings and any recommendations for legislation to the
