- 6 The department of natural resources shall determine the lease rate 7 for amateur radio electronic repeater sites and units available for 8 public service communication. ((For the first repeater unit placed at 9 a department communication site by an amateur radio lessee eligible for 10 a reduced rate under this section, the lessee shall pay fifty percent of the amateur radio rental established by the department. For any 11 12 subsequent repeater unit placed at the same facility by an eligible 13 amateur radio lessee, the lessee shall pay twenty-five percent of the 14 rental established by the department)) The lease rate may not exceed 15 one hundred dollars for each repeater site made available for public
- The amateur radio regulatory authority approved by the federal communication commission shall assign the radio frequencies used by amateur radio lessees. The department shall develop guidelines to

- 1 determine which lessees are to receive reduced rental fees as moneys
- 2 are available by legislative appropriation to pay a portion of the rent
- 3 for electronic repeaters operated by amateur radio operators.
