1 AN ACT Relating to removal of ordinary health care expense from the  
2 child support economic table; and amending RCW 26.19.080 and 26.19.020.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 26.19.080 and 1990 1st ex.s. c 2 s 7 are each amended  
5 to read as follows:

6 (1) The basic child support obligation derived from the economic  
7 table shall be allocated between the parents based on each parent's  
8 share of the combined monthly net income.

9 (2) (~~Ordinary health care expenses are included in the economic~~  
10 ~~table. Monthly health care expenses that exceed five percent of the~~  
11 ~~basic support obligation shall be considered extraordinary health care~~  
12 ~~expenses. Extraordinary health care~~) Health care expenses for the  
13 children are not included in the economic table. These expenses shall  
14 be shared by the parents in the same proportion as the basic child  
15 support obligation.

16 (3) Day care and special child rearing expenses, such as tuition  
17 and long-distance transportation costs to and from the parents for  
18 visitation purposes, are not included in the economic table. These

1 expenses shall be shared by the parents in the same proportion as the  
2 basic child support obligation.

3 (4) The court may exercise its discretion to determine the  
4 necessity for and the reasonableness of all amounts ordered in excess  
5 of the basic child support obligation.

6 **Sec. 2.** RCW 26.19.020 and 1991 c 367 s 25 are each amended to read  
7 as follows:

33           The economic table is presumptive for combined monthly net incomes  
34 up to and including five thousand dollars. When combined monthly net

38 reason to deviate below that amount. The economic table is advisory
