- 1 AN ACT Relating to discrimination by school district employees or
- 2 school district employee organizations; adding a new section to chapter
- 3 28A.150 RCW; creating a new section; and prescribing penalties.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that all persons,
- 6 regardless of their political and religious beliefs, should be
- 7 encouraged to express their views in the public debate over school
- 8 curriculum and school district policy. The legislature further finds
- 9 that discrimination should not occur, and that there should not be
- 10 attempts by school district employees and school district employee
- 11 organizations to discredit the views of certain religious and political
- 12 groups. The legislature intends to prohibit such discrimination.
- 13 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 28A.150
- 14 RCW to read as follows:
- 15 (1) School district employees and school district employee
- 16 organizations shall not discriminate against parents or other persons
- 17 based on association or perceived association with political or
- 18 religious groups. This prohibition against discrimination extends to

- 1 activity involving the preparation, publication, or distribution of
- 2 literature or manuals produced for the purpose of influencing school
- 3 district or public policy or discrediting, or promoting discriminating
- 4 against, any parent, group, or member of a religious or political
- 5 group.
- 6 (2) A violation of this section is a misdemeanor punishable in accordance with RCW 9A.20.010.
