1 AN ACT Relating to charges against industrial insurance awards; and 2 amending RCW 51.32.040.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **sec. 1.** RCW 51.32.040 and 1987 c 75 s 7 are each amended to read 5 as follows:

No money paid or payable under this title shall, except as provided 6 for in RCW 43.20B.720, 50.20.085, or 74.20A.260, prior to the issuance 7 8 and delivery of the check or warrant therefor, be capable of being assigned, charged, or ever be taken in execution or attached or 9 10 garnished, nor shall the same pass, or be paid, to any other person by operation of law, or by any form of voluntary assignment, or power of 11 12 Any such assignment or charge shall be void, unless the attorney. 13 transfer is to a financial institution at the request of a worker or 14 other beneficiary and in accordance with RCW 51.32.045 shall be made: 15 PROVIDED, That if any worker suffers a permanent partial injury, and dies from some other cause than the accident which produced such injury 16 17 before he or she shall have received payment of his or her award for such permanent partial injury, or if any worker suffers any other 18 injury before he or she shall have received payment of any monthly 19

installment covering any period of time prior to his or her death, the 1 2 amount of such permanent partial award, or of such monthly payment or both, shall be paid to the surviving spouse, or to the child or 3 4 children if there is no surviving spouse: PROVIDED FURTHER, That, if 5 any worker suffers an injury and dies therefrom before he or she shall have received payment of any monthly installment covering time loss for 6 7 any period of time prior to his or her death, the amount of such 8 monthly payment shall be paid to the surviving spouse, or to the child 9 or children if there is no surviving spouse: PROVIDED FURTHER, That 10 any application for compensation under the foregoing provisos of this section shall be filed with the department or self-insuring employer 11 within one year of the date of death: PROVIDED FURTHER, That if the 12 injured worker resided in the United States as long as three years 13 prior to the date of injury, such payment shall not be made to any 14 15 surviving spouse or child who was at the time of the injury a nonresident of the United States: PROVIDED FURTHER, That any worker 16 receiving benefits under this title who is subsequently confined in, or 17 who subsequently becomes eligible therefor while confined in any 18 19 institution under conviction and sentence shall have all payments of 20 such compensation canceled during the period of confinement but after discharge from the institution payment of benefits thereafter due shall 21 be paid if such worker would, but for the provisions of this proviso, 22 otherwise be entitled thereto: PROVIDED FURTHER, That if any prisoner 23 24 is injured in the course of his or her employment while participating 25 in a work or training release program authorized by chapter 72.65 RCW 26 and is subject to the provisions of this title, he or she shall be entitled to payments under this title subject to the requirements of 27 chapter 72.65 RCW unless his or her participation in such program has 28 29 been canceled, or unless he or she is returned to a state correctional 30 institution, as defined in RCW 72.65.010(3), as a result of revocation of parole or new sentence: PROVIDED FURTHER, That if such incarcerated 31 worker has during such confinement period, any beneficiaries, they 32 shall be paid directly the monthly benefits which would have been paid 33 to him or her for himself or herself and his or her beneficiaries had 34 35 he or she not been so confined. Any lump sum benefits to which the worker would otherwise be entitled but for the provisions of these 36 37 provisos shall be paid on a monthly basis to his or her beneficiaries.
