- 1 AN ACT Relating to public assistance applicants; amending RCW
- 2 43.43.500; and adding a new section to chapter 74.08 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 74.08 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (1) The department shall establish a terminal facility to gain
- 7 access to the Washington state crime information center to determine
- 8 whether applicants for public assistance are fugitives from justice.
- 9 If the department determines that an applicant is a fugitive from
- 10 justice, the department shall (a) contact the appropriate law
- 11 enforcement agency; and (b) deny the application for assistance.
- 12 (2) The department shall seek all necessary federal approvals and
- 13 waivers to comply with this section.
- 14 Sec. 2. RCW 43.43.500 and 1967 ex.s. c 27 s 1 are each amended to
- 15 read as follows:
- 16 There is established the Washington state crime information center
- 17 to be located in the records division of the Washington state patrol
- 18 and to function under the direction of the chief of the Washington

state patrol. The center shall serve to coordinate crime information, 1 by means of data processing, for all law enforcement agencies in the 2 3 state. It shall make such use of the facilities of the law enforcement 4 teletype system as is practical. It shall provide access to the national crime information center, to motor vehicle and driver license 5 information and to such other public records as may be accessed by data 6 7 processing and which are pertinent to law enforcement. The center 8 shall provide access to the department of social and health services to 9 make determinations required under section 1 of this act.
