- 1 AN ACT Relating to travel allowance or reimbursement for school
- 2 employees; and adding a new section to chapter 28A.400 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 28A.400 5 RCW to read as follows:
- 6 (1) School district administrators, including, but not limited to,
- 7 superintendents, assistant superintendents, associate superintendents,
- 8 executive directors, finance managers, personnel directors, principals,
- 9 and assistant principals, may not be provided a travel allowance or
- 10 receive compensation or reimbursement for in-district travel expenses,
- 11 including mileage.
- 12 (2) Other school district personnel may not be provided a travel
- 13 allowance or receive compensation or reimbursement for in-district
- 14 mileage traveled unless such travel is specified as an inherent part of
- 15 the job in a written job description, is approved in writing before the
- 16 travel occurs, is essential to adequate performance of job
- 17 responsibility, is the least costly alternative available to the
- 18 employee, and has not been considered in establishing the salary rate
- 19 of the employee.

1 (3) School district personnel may not be provided a travel 2 allowance or receive compensation or reimbursement for out-of-district 3 mileage in an amount greater than the internal revenue service travel 4 allowance for mileage current at the time the travel occurred.
