- 1 AN ACT Relating to library facilities; adding a new section to
- 2 chapter 36.32 RCW; adding a new chapter to Title 27 RCW; and repealing
- 3 RCW 27.14.010, 27.14.015, 27.14.020, 27.14.030, 27.14.035, 27.14.040,
- 4 and 27.14.050.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that it is in the
- 7 interests of the people of the state of Washington to be able to
- 8 establish library capital facility areas as quasi-municipal
- 9 corporations and independent taxing units existing within the
- 10 boundaries of existing rural library districts, rural intercounty
- 11 library districts, rural partial-county library districts, or island
- 12 library districts, for the purpose of financing the construction of
- 13 capital library facilities.
- 14 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** Unless the context clearly requires
- 15 otherwise, the definitions in this section apply throughout this
- 16 chapter.

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- 1 (1) "Library district" means rural library district, rural 2 intercounty library district, rural partial-county library district, or 3 island library district.
- 4 (2) "Library capital facility area" means a quasi-municipal corporation and independent taxing authority within the meaning of 5 Article VII, section 1 of the state Constitution, and a taxing district 6 7 within the meaning of Article VII, section 2 of the state Constitution, 8 created by a county legislative authority of one or several counties. 9 A library capital facility area shall include property that has an 10 assessed valuation of at least fifty million dollars and may include all or a portion of a city or town. 11
- <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** Upon receipt of a completed written request 12 13 signed by a majority of the members of the board of trustees of a 14 library district, the county legislative authority or county 15 legislative authorities for the county or counties in which a proposed library capital facility area is to be established shall adopt an 16 ordinance creating a library capital facility area. A completed 17 18 request submitted under this section shall include: (1) A description 19 of the boundaries of the library capital facility area; (2) copies of resolutions of the legislative authorities of any cities and towns and 20 of the boards of trustees of any adjoining library districts, that are 21 included in whole or in part within the described library capital 22 23 facility area, indicating agreement to the formation of the library 24 capital facility area; and (3) copies of resolutions adopted by the 25 board of trustees of the requesting library district, and of the legislative authorities of any cities and towns and of the boards of 26 27 trustees of any adjoining library districts, that are included in the proposed library capital facility area, indicating agreement with 28 29 regard to the payment of the costs of any election for approval of 30 bonded indebtedness.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 4. The governing body of the library capital facility area shall be three members of the county legislative authority from each county in which the library capital facility area is located. In counties that have more than three members of their legislative body, the three members who shall serve on the governing body of the library capital facility area shall be chosen by the full membership of the county legislative authority. Where the library

- 2 be represented by less than three members by mutual agreement of the

- 4 NEW SECTION. Sec. 5. The governing body of the library capital facility area may, by interlocal agreement or otherwise, contract with 5 a county, city, town, or library district to design, administer the 6 7 construction of, operate, or maintain a library capital facility financed pursuant to this chapter. Legal title to library capital 8 9 facilities acquired or constructed pursuant to this chapter may be 10 transferred, acquired, or held by the library capital facility area or a county, city, town, or library district in which the facility is 11
- 13 NEW SECTION. Sec. 6. (1) A library capital facility area may contract indebtedness or borrow money to finance library capital 14 facilities and may issue general obligation bonds for such purpose not 15 exceeding an amount, together with any existing indebtedness of the 16 17 library capital facility area, equal to one and one-quarter percent of 18 the value of the taxable property in the district and impose excess property tax levies to retire the general indebtedness as provided in 19 20 RCW 39.36.050 if a ballot proposition authorizing both the indebtedness 21 and excess levies is approved by at least three-fifths of the voters of 22 the library capital facility area voting on the proposition, and the 23 total number of voters voting on the proposition constitutes not less 24 than forty percent of the total number of voters in the library capital 25 facility area voting at the last preceding general election. "value of the taxable property" has the meaning set forth in RCW 26 27 39.36.015. The term "library capital facilities" includes both real 28 and personal property including, but not limited to, land, buildings, 29 site improvements, equipment, furnishings, and collections and all related to acquisition, 30 necessary costs financing, design, construction, remodeling, and installation. 31
- 32 (2) A library capital facility area may accept gifts or grants of 33 money or property of any kind for the same purposes for which it is 34 authorized to borrow money in subsection (1) of this section.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 7. (1) A library capital facility area may be dissolved by a majority vote of the governing body when all obligations

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- 1 under any general obligation bonds issued by the library capital
- 2 facility area have been discharged and any other contractual
- 3 obligations of the library capital facility area have either been
- 4 discharged or assumed by another governmental entity.
- 5 (2) A library capital facility area shall be dissolved by the
- 6 governing body in the event that the initial two elections conducted to
- 7 authorize an excess levy as authorized under section 6 of this act fail
- 8 to receive the number of votes necessary for approval.
- 9 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 8.** A new section is added to chapter 36.32 RCW
- 10 to read as follows:
- 11 A county legislative authority may establish a library capital
- 12 facility area pursuant to chapter 27.-- RCW (sections 1 through 7 of
- 13 this act).
- 14 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 9.** The following acts or parts of acts are each
- 15 repealed:
- 16 (1) RCW 27.14.010 and 1961 c 162 s 1;
- 17 (2) RCW 27.14.015 and 1963 c 80 s 5;
- 18 (3) RCW 27.14.020 and 1963 c 80 s 1 & 1961 c 162 s 2;
- 19 (4) RCW 27.14.030 and 1963 c 80 s 2 & 1961 c 162 s 3;
- 20 (5) RCW 27.14.035 and 1963 c 80 s 3;
- 21 (6) RCW 27.14.040 and 1963 c 80 s 4 & 1961 c 162 s 4; and
- 22 (7) RCW 27.14.050 and 1961 c 162 s 5.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 10. Sections 1 through 7 of this act shall
- 24 constitute a new chapter in Title 27 RCW.

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
