- 4 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 9.41 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 It is unlawful for any person, except law enforcement officers, to
- carry, transport, convey, or to have in his or her possession or under
- his or her control any firearm while in the following buildings located 8
- 9 on the west state capitol campus grounds:
- 10 (1) Legislative Building;

- (2) John L. O'Brien Building; 11
- (3) John A. Cherberg Building; 12
- (4) Temple of Justice; and 13
- 14 (5) Governor's Mansion.
- 15 This section does not apply to any person licensed under RCW
- 9.41.070 who, before entering any capitol campus building listed in 16
- 17 this section, immediately notifies the Washington state patrol that
- they are in possession of a concealed weapon. This section shall not 18
- restrict any person from carrying, transporting, or to have in his or 19

- 1 her possession, any firearms for the express purpose of demonstration
- 2 or lecture involving the exhibition of firearms.
- 3 Any person violating this section is guilty of a misdemeanor.
