- 2 caseworkers; amending RCW 74.14B.010; and adding a new section to
- 3 chapter 74.14B RCW.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 74.14B.010 and 1987 c 503 s 8 are each amended to read 6 as follows:
- 7 Caseworkers employed in children services shall meet minimum
- 8 standards established by the department of social and health services.
- 9 Comprehensive training for caseworkers shall be completed before such
- 10 caseworkers are assigned to case-carrying responsibilities ((without
- 11 direct supervision)). Before being assigned any cases, caseworkers
- 12 <u>shall successfully pass competency examinations designed to demonstrate</u>
- 13 the ability of the caseworker to fulfill the responsibilities of his or
- 14 her position successfully. Intermittent, part-time, and standby
- 15 workers shall be subject to the same minimum standards ((and)),
- 16 training, and examinations.
- 17 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 74.14B RCW
- 18 to read as follows:

- The competency examination required under RCW 74.14B.010 shall cover applicable state statutes, rules, and policies related to the
- 3 investigation, handling, and disposition of child abuse and neglect
