- 1 AN ACT Relating to a manufacturing technology extension system;
- 2 adding a new section to chapter 43.63A RCW; making an appropriation;
- 3 providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 43.63A RCW 6 to read as follows:
- 7 In cooperation with recipients of federal technology assistance
- 8 project grants the department of community, trade, and economic
- 9 development shall establish a state-wide manufacturing technology
- 10 extension system to provide state-of-the-art technical assistance to
- 11 Washington manufacturers.
- 12 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** The sum of one million dollars, or as much
- 13 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for the biennium ending
- 14 June 30, 1997, from the general fund to the department of community,
- 15 trade, and economic development solely for contracts with recipients of
- 16 federal technology assistance project grants under section 1 of this
- 17 act.

- 3 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take

4 effect July 1, 1995.
