- 1 AN ACT Relating to clarifying the illegality of strikes by
- 2 educational employees; and adding a new section to chapter 41.59 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 41.59 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 The right of educational employees to engage in any strike is
- 7 prohibited. The right of a school district board of directors to
- 8 engage in a lockout of educational employees is prohibited. Should
- 9 either a strike or lockout occur, the representative of the educational
- 10 employees or board of directors may invoke the jurisdiction of the
- 11 superior court in the county in which the labor dispute exists and such
- 12 court shall have jurisdiction to issue an appropriate order against
- 13 either or both parties. In fashioning an order, the court shall take
- 14 into consideration not only the elements necessary for injunctive
- 15 relief but also the purpose and goals of this chapter and any
- 16 mitigating factors such as the commission of an unfair labor practice
- 17 by either party.
