- 1 AN ACT Relating to the deaf and hard of hearing; and adding a new
- 2 section to chapter 28A.155 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 28A.155 5 RCW to read as follows:
- 6 School districts shall notify the department of social and health
- 7 services, office of deaf and hard of hearing services, of students who
- 8 are identified by the school district as being deaf or hard of hearing
- 9 as defined by rules of the superintendent of public instruction. The
- 10 purpose of the notification is to increase the availability of services
- 11 to these students.
- 12 School districts shall send a list of deaf and hard of hearing
- 13 students who were enrolled in the district during the 1994-95 school
- 14 year to the office of deaf and hard of hearing services by September 1,
- 15 1995. For the 1995-96 school year and thereafter, school districts
- 16 shall notify the office within thirty days after a student has been
- 17 identified as being deaf or hard of hearing.
