- 1 AN ACT Relating to higher education; creating new sections; and
- 2 making an appropriation.

- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. It is the intent of the legislature to
- 5 improve the education and training of students preparing for leadership
 - positions in public service. To that end, this act establishes a
- 7 permanent chair in the graduate school of public affairs at the
- 8 University of Washington through an endowment financed in equal parts
- 9 by public and private funds.
- 10 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** The sum of seven hundred fifty thousand
- 11 dollars, or as much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for
- 12 the biennium ending June 30, 1997, from the general fund to the
- 13 University of Washington for the purposes of establishing an endowment
- 14 for a permanent chair in the graduate school of public affairs.
- 15 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** The University of Washington shall provide
- 16 private funds in an amount equal to or greater than seven hundred fifty

- 1 thousand dollars or the appropriation in section 2 of this act shall
- 2 lapse.
