- 1 AN ACT Relating to limiting regular property taxes; and amending
- 2 RCW 84.55.010.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 Sec. 1. RCW 84.55.010 and 1979 ex.s. c 218 s 2 are each amended to 5 read as follows:
- 6 (1) Except as provided in this chapter, the levy for a taxing
- district in any year shall be set so that the regular property taxes
- 8 payable in the following year shall not exceed one hundred six percent
- 9 or one hundred percent plus the rate of inflation, whichever is lower,
- 10 of the amount of regular property taxes lawfully levied for such
- 11 district in the highest of the three most recent years in which such
- 12 taxes were levied for such district plus an additional dollar amount
- 13 calculated by multiplying the increase in assessed value in that
- 14 district resulting from new construction, improvements to property, and
- 15 any increase in the assessed value of state-assessed property by the
- 16 regular property tax levy rate of that district for the preceding year.
- 17 (2) For the purposes of this section, "inflation" means the
- 18 percentage change in the implicit price deflator for the United States

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- 1 for each fiscal year as published by the federal bureau of labor
- 2 statistics.

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
