- 2 amending RCW 18.160.020.

State of Washington

- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 18.160.020 and 1990 c 177 s 3 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 (1) A municipality or county may not enact an order, ordinance,
- 7 rule, or regulation requiring a fire protection sprinkler system
- 8 contractor to obtain a fire sprinkler contractor license from the
- 9 municipality or county. However, a municipality or county may require
- 10 a fire protection sprinkler system contractor to obtain a permit and
- 11 pay a fee for the installation of a fire protection sprinkler system
- 12 and require the installation of such systems to conform with the
- building code or other construction requirements of the municipality or county, but may not impose financial responsibility requirements other
- 15 than proof of a valid license.
- 16 (2) This chapter does not apply to:
- 17 (a) United States, state, and local government employees, building
- 18 officials, fire marshals, fire inspectors, or insurance inspectors when
- 19 acting in their official capacities;

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1	(b)	Α	person	or	organization	acting	under	court	order;
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- 2 (c) A person or organization that sells or supplies products or 3 materials to a licensed fire protection sprinkler system contractor;
- 4 (d) A registered professional engineer acting solely in a 5 professional capacity;
- 6 (e) An employee of a licensed fire protection sprinkler system 7 contractor performing duties for the registered fire protection 8 sprinkler system contractor; ((and))
- 9 (f) An owner/occupier of a single-family residence performing his 10 or her own installation in that residence; and
- 11 (g) A plumber certified under chapter 18.106 RCW performing
 12 installation in a building less than three stories in height that is
 13 either a single-family residence or containing fifteen or less units.

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
