1 AN ACT Relating to minimum retirement benefits; and amending RCW 2 43.43.277.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 43.43.277 and 1987 c 173 s 2 are each amended to read 5 as follows:

6 (((1) The benefits provided under subsection (2) of this section 7 shall be available only to surviving spouses whose allowances commenced 8 before January 1, 1970, and who are not receiving and are not eligible 9 for federal old age, survivors, or disability benefits.

10 (2) Effective July 1, 1987,)) <u>The minimum retirement benefit</u> 11 provided ((pursuant to)) <u>under:</u>

12 (1) RCW 43.43.260 and 43.43.270(1) to the member shall not be less 13 than five hundred dollars per month; and

14 (2) RCW 43.43.275(1) to surviving spouses ((who meet the 15 qualifications in subsection (1) of this section)) shall be twenty-16 three dollars per month per year of service. However, the minimum 17 benefit for the surviving spouse of a member who died in service ((who 18 meets the qualifications in subsection (1) of this section)) shall be 19 calculated using twenty years of service or the member's actual years

- 1 of service, whichever is greater. <u>A benefit under this subsection</u>
- 2 shall not be less than five hundred dollars per month.
