1 AN ACT Relating to the sales tax on highway and ferry construction
2 contracts; adding new sections to chapter 82.32 RCW; creating a new
3 section; and declaring an emergency.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** It is the intent of the legislature, if
6 motor vehicle fuel tax rate increases are approved by the voters at the
7 next general election, that the increased state sales or use tax
8 revenue collected on state highway and ferry contracts associated with
9 those increases in the motor vehicle fuel tax shall be deposited into
10 the transportation fund.

11 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 82.32 RCW
12 to read as follows:

13 Beginning January 1, 1996, the department of revenue shall deposit
14 into the transportation fund all moneys received from the imposition of
15 the taxes paid under chapters 82.08 and 82.12 RCW on state highway and
16 ferry construction contracts that are attributable to increases in the
17 motor vehicle fuel tax rate imposed under chapter 82.36 RCW that have
18 been approved by the voters in the 1995 general election.

1 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** A new section is added to chapter 82.32 RCW
2 to read as follows:

3 The departments of revenue and transportation shall collaboratively
4 develop a process for determining that portion of taxes paid under
5 chapters 82.08 and 82.12 RCW that are paid on state highway and ferry
6 construction contracts related to the motor vehicle fuel tax rate
7 increases approved by the voters in the 1995 general election. The
8 process shall be agreed upon prior to the 1995 general election to
9 provide adequate time for any budget, accounting, computer system, or
10 other changes that may be necessary if the voters approve the increased
11 motor vehicle fuel tax rate.

12 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 4.** This act is necessary for the immediate
13 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
14 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take
15 effect immediately.
