- 1 AN ACT Relating to sales and use tax exemptions for research and
- 2 development; adding a new section to chapter 82.08 RCW; adding a new
- 3 section to chapter 82.12 RCW; and providing an effective date.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 82.08 RCW
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 The tax levied by RCW 82.08.020 shall not apply to sales of human
- 8 blood, tissue, organs, bodies, or body parts for medical research and
- 9 quality control testing purposes.
- 10 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 82.12 RCW
- 11 to read as follows:
- 12 The provisions of this chapter shall not apply in respect to the
- 13 use of human blood, tissue, organs, bodies, or body parts for medical
- 14 research and quality control testing purposes.
- 15 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** This act shall take effect July 1, 1996.
