- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 2.08.065 and 1992 c 189 s 5 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 There shall be in the county of Grant, two judges of the superior
- 7 court; in the county of Okanogan, one judge of the superior court; in
- 8 the county of Mason, two judges of the superior court; in the county of
- 9 Thurston, ((six)) eight judges of the superior court; in the counties
- 10 of Pacific and Wahkiakum jointly, one judge of the superior court; in
- 11 the counties of Ferry, Pend Oreille, and Stevens jointly, two judges of
- 12 the superior court; and in the counties of San Juan and Island jointly,
- 13 two judges of the superior court.
- 14 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** The additional judicial positions created by
- 15 section 1 of this act are effective only if Thurston county through its
- 16 duly constituted legislative authority documents its approval of the
- 17 additional positions and its agreement that it will pay out of county
- 18 funds, without reimbursement from the state, the expenses of the

- 3 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** One judicial position created by section 1
- 4 of this act shall be effective February 1, 1997; the second position
