- 1 AN ACT Relating to a member who dies prior to receiving the first
- 2 disability retirement payment; and amending RCW 41.40.270.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 41.40.270 and 1995 c 144 s 5 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 (1) Should a member die before the date of retirement the amount of
  7 the accumulated contributions standing to the member's credit in the
  8 employees' savings fund, less any amount identified as owing to an
  9 obligee upon withdrawal of accumulated contributions pursuant to a
  10 court order filed under RCW 41.50.670, at the time of death:
- 11 (a) Shall be paid to the member's estate, or such person or 12 persons, trust, or organization as the member shall have nominated by 13 written designation duly executed and filed with the department; or
- 14 (b) If there be no such designated person or persons still living 15 at the time of the member's death, or if a member fails to file a new 16 beneficiary designation subsequent to marriage, remarriage, dissolution 17 divorce, or reestablishment of membership following of marriage, withdrawal 18 termination by or retirement, such 19 contributions, less any amount identified as owing to an obligee upon

- withdrawal of accumulated contributions pursuant to a court order filed under RCW 41.50.670, shall be paid to the surviving spouse as if in fact such spouse had been nominated by written designation as aforesaid, or if there be no such surviving spouse, then to the member's legal representatives.
- (2) Upon the death in service, or while on authorized leave of 6 7 absence for a period not to exceed one hundred and twenty days from the 8 date of payroll separation, of any member who is qualified but has not 9 applied for a service retirement allowance or has completed ten years of service at the time of death, the designated beneficiary, or the 10 surviving spouse as provided in subsection (1) of this section, may 11 elect to waive the payment provided by subsection (1) of this section. 12 Upon such an election, a joint and one hundred percent survivor option 13 under RCW 41.40.188, calculated under the retirement allowance 14 described in RCW 41.40.185 or 41.40.190, whichever is greater, 15 16 actuarially reduced by the amount of any lump sum benefit identified as owing to an obligee upon withdrawal of accumulated contributions 17 pursuant to a court order filed under RCW 41.50.670 shall automatically 18 19 be given effect as if selected for the benefit of the designated If the member is not then qualified for a service 20 beneficiary. retirement allowance, such benefit shall be based upon the actuarial 21 equivalent of the sum necessary to pay the accrued regular retirement 22 allowance commencing when the deceased member would have first 23 24 qualified for a service retirement allowance.
  - (3) Subsection (1) of this section, unless elected, shall not apply to any member who has applied for service retirement in RCW 41.40.180, as now or hereafter amended, and thereafter dies between the date of separation from service and the member's effective retirement date, where the member has selected a survivorship option under RCW 41.40.188. In those cases the beneficiary named in the member's final application for service retirement may elect to receive either a cash refund, less any amount identified as owing to an obligee upon withdrawal of accumulated contributions pursuant to a court order filed under RCW 41.50.670, or monthly payments according to the option selected by the member.
- 36 (4) If a member who has received a determination of disability
  37 under RCW 41.40.230 and has selected a retirement option under RCW
  38 41.40.188 dies before receiving the first retirement payment, the
  39 beneficiary named in the member's final application for service
