- 1 AN ACT Relating to marriages; amending RCW 26.04.020; and adding a
- 2 new section to chapter 26.04 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 26.04.020 and 1927 c 189 s 1 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 (1) Marriages in the following cases are prohibited:
- 7  $((\frac{1}{1}))$  (a) When either party thereto has a wife or husband living
- 8 at the time of such marriage((-)):
- 9  $((\frac{(2)}{2}))$  When the parties thereto are nearer of kin to each
- 10 other than second cousins, whether of the whole or half blood computing
- 11 by the rules of the civil law; or
- 12 (c) When the parties are persons of the same gender.
- 13  $((\frac{3}{2}))$  (2) It shall be unlawful for any man to marry his father's
- 14 sister, mother's sister, daughter, sister, son's daughter, daughter's
- 15 daughter, brother's daughter or sister's daughter; it shall be unlawful
- 16 for any woman to marry her father's brother, mother's brother, son,
- 17 brother, son's son, daughter's son, brother's son or sister's son.

- NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 26.04 RCW to read as follows:
- A marriage that is valid in another jurisdiction but is prohibited under RCW 26.04.020 shall not be recognized as a valid marriage in this state.
