1 AN ACT Relating to the method of execution; amending RCW 10.95.180; 2 and prescribing penalties.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 10.95.180 and 1986 c 194 s 1 are each amended to read 5 as follows:

б punishment of death shall (1)The be supervised by the 7 superintendent of the penitentiary and shall be inflicted ((either by hanging by the neck or, at the election of the defendant,)) by 8 9 intravenous injection of a substance or substances in a lethal quantity 10 sufficient to cause death and until the defendant is dead, or, at the election of the defendant, by hanging by the neck until the defendant 11 In any case, death shall be pronounced by a licensed 12 <u>is dead</u>. physician. 13

(2) All executions, for both men and women, shall be carried outwithin the walls of the state penitentiary.

16 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** If any provision of this act or its 17 application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the
