- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 26.04.160 and 1993 c 451 s 1 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 (1) Application for a marriage license must be made and filed with
- 7 the appropriate county auditor upon blanks ((to be)) provided by the
- 8 county auditor ((for that purpose, which)). The application shall be
- 9 under the oath of each ((<del>of the applicants, and</del>)) <u>applicant.</u> Each
- 10 application ((shall)) must state ((the)) each applicant's name, current
- 11 address ((at the time of execution of application)), age, birthplace,
- 12 whether <u>the applicants are</u> single, widowed or divorced, <u>under a</u>
- 13 <u>superior court or administrative order to pay support for a child,</u>
- 14 <u>dependent person, or former spouse and in what monthly amounts</u>, ((and))
- 15 whether under control of a guardian, and residence during the past six
- 16 months((: PROVIDED, That)). Each county may require ((such)) other
