- 1 AN ACT Relating to immunization; creating new sections; making
- 2 appropriations; and declaring an emergency.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that:
- 5 (1) Parents and guardians of children are often unaware of the need
- 6 for timely immunizations and the public health risks of the failure to
- 7 be properly immunized.
- 8 (2) Physicians often lack up-to-date information on the status of
- 9 their patients' immunizations, which increases the risks of over and
- 10 under-immunization that can be costly both in terms of health risks and
- 11 dollars.
- 12 (3) Child profile projects in four counties have been created to
- 13 address these concerns and provide the information needed to develop a
- 14 state-wide tracking and reminder system.
- 15 The legislature declares that it is in the public health interest
- 16 of the people of the state of Washington that all children be properly
- 17 immunized and that a plan be developed to create a state-wide child
- 18 profile system for tracking data and reminders for immunizations, thus

- 1 enabling the state to reach the ninety percent immunization rate set
- 2 forth in the public health improvement plan.
- 3 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** The secretary of health shall develop a plan
- 4 for analyzing the progress of the four current child profile counties
- 5 and making recommendations for expanding the project to other counties.
- 6 The plan for expansion must take into account the current immunization
- 7 rate for children between the ages of birth and two, goals set by the
- 8 local health departments in conjunction with their own public health
- 9 improvement plan work plans, and estimated population growth. The
- 10 secretary shall submit recommendations to the appropriate standing
- 11 committees of the senate and the house of representatives on the
- 12 proposed timeline for expansion of child profile, with a goal of state-
- 13 wide coverage.
- 14 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** (1) The sum of three hundred sixty thousand
- 15 dollars, or as much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for
- 16 the biennium ending June 30, 1997, from the general fund to the
- 17 department of health for the sole purpose of stabilizing the four
- 18 existing child profile counties.
- 19 (2) The sum of dollars, or as much thereof as may be
- 20 necessary, is appropriated for the biennium ending June 30, 1997, from
- 21 the general fund to the department of health for the purposes of
- 22 development of a state-wide immunization tracking and reminder system.
- 23 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** This act is necessary for the immediate
- 24 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
- 25 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take
- 26 effect immediately.
