- 2 commemoration; and adding a new section to chapter 27.34 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 27.34 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (1) The Washington state historical society shall work with and 7 provide leadership to the Lewis and Clark trail committee in planning 8 activities to commemorate Lewis and Clark's epic exploration to the 9 northwest United States.
- 10 (2) The society shall coordinate its planning efforts with the 11 parks and recreation commission, which provides staffing and 12 administrative assistance to the Lewis and Clark trail committee.
- 13 (3) The society shall work with other associations and state 14 agencies to coordinate, develop, and disseminate information regarding 15 the planned activities.
