- 1 AN ACT Relating to personal flotation devices; amending RCW
- 2 88.12.115; and prescribing penalties.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 88.12.115 and 1993 c 244 s 14 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 (1) No person may operate or permit the operation of a vessel on
- 7 the waters of the state without a personal flotation device on board
- 8 for each person on the vessel. Each personal flotation device shall be
- 9 in serviceable condition, of an appropriate size, and readily
- 10 accessible.
- 11 (2) No person may operate or permit to be operated a vessel under
- 12 <u>nineteen feet in length unless each person nine years of age or younger</u>
- 13 <u>on the vessel wears a United States coast guard-approved personal</u>
- 14 <u>flotation device</u>.
- 15 (3) Except as provided in RCW 88.12.015, a violation of subsection
- 16 (1) or (2) of this section is an infraction under chapter 7.84 RCW if
- 17 the vessel is not carrying passengers for hire.
