- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 18.130 RCW
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 The disciplinary authority shall provide a program in continuing
- 8 education in the recognition of symptoms of drug and alcohol dependency
- 9 in patients in clinical settings, in accordance with uniform recognized
- 10 standards developed in consultation with the secretary and the
- 11 department of social and health services.
- 12 **Sec. 2.** RCW 74.14B.010 and 1987 c 503 s 8 are each amended to read
- 13 as follows:
- 14 Caseworkers employed in children services shall meet minimum
- 15 standards established by the department of social and health services.
- 16 Comprehensive training for caseworkers shall be completed before such
- 17 caseworkers are assigned to case-carrying responsibilities without
- 18 direct supervision. The comprehensive training must include the

- 1 recognition of symptoms of drug and alcohol dependency in patients in
- 2 <u>clinical settings in accordance with recognized standards.</u>
- 3 Intermittent, part-time, and standby workers shall be subject to the
- 4 same minimum standards and training.
