1 AN ACT Relating to obsolete provisions in the state even start
2 program; and amending RCW 28B.06.040 and 28B.06.050.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 28B.06.040 and 1987 c 518 s 107 are each amended to
5 read as follows:

6 The (~~superintendent of public instruction~~) state board for
7 community and technical colleges is authorized and directed, whenever
8 possible, to fund or cooperatively work with existing adult literacy
9 programs and parenting related programs offered through the common
10 school and community and technical college systems(~~(, vocational~~
11 ~~technical institutes,~~) or community-based, nonprofit organizations to
12 provide services for eligible parents before developing and funding new
13 adult literacy programs to carry out the purposes of project even
14 start.

15 **Sec. 2.** RCW 28B.06.050 and 1987 c 518 s 108 are each amended to
16 read as follows:

17 The (~~superintendent of public instruction shall evaluate and~~
18 ~~submit to the legislature by January 15, 1988, a report on the~~

1 effectiveness of project even start. The initial report shall include,
2 if appropriate, recommendations relating to the expansion of project
3 even start. The superintendent)) state board for community and
4 technical colleges shall submit a report to the legislature on project
5 even start ((every two years after the initial report)) January 15th of
6 even-numbered years.
