1       AN ACT Relating to deductions from motor vehicle funds to cities  
2 and towns; and reenacting and amending RCW 46.68.110.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4       **Sec. 1.** RCW 46.68.110 and 1991 sp.s. c 15 s 46 and 1991 c 342 s 59  
5 are each reenacted and amended to read as follows:

6       Funds credited to the incorporated cities and towns of the state as  
7 set forth in ((~~subdivision (1) of~~)) RCW 46.68.100(1) shall be subject  
8 to deduction and distribution as follows:

9       (1) One and one-half percent of such sums shall be deducted monthly  
10 as such sums are credited and set aside for the use of the department  
11 of transportation for the supervision of work and expenditures of such  
12 incorporated cities and towns on the city and town streets thereof,  
13 including the supervision and administration of federal-aid programs  
14 for which the department of transportation has responsibility:  
15 PROVIDED, That any moneys so retained and not expended shall be  
16 credited in the succeeding biennium to the incorporated cities and  
17 towns in proportion to deductions herein made;

18       (2) Thirty-three one-hundredths of one percent of such funds shall  
19 be deducted monthly, as such funds accrue, and set aside for the use of

1 the department of transportation for the purpose of funding the cities'  
2 share of the costs of highway jurisdiction studies and other studies.  
3 Any funds so retained and not expended shall be credited in the  
4 succeeding biennium to the cities in proportion to the deductions made;

5 (3) (~~From April 1, 1992, two~~) One percent of such funds shall be  
6 deducted monthly, as such funds accrue, to be deposited in the city  
7 hardship assistance account, hereby created in the motor vehicle fund,  
8 to implement the city hardship assistance program, as provided in RCW  
9 47.26.164. However, any moneys so retained and not required to carry  
10 out the program as of July 1, 1996, and July 1st of each odd-numbered  
11 year thereafter, shall be provided within sixty days to the treasurer  
12 and distributed in the manner prescribed in subsection (4) of this  
13 section;

14 (4) The balance remaining to the credit of incorporated cities and  
15 towns after such deduction shall be apportioned monthly as such funds  
16 accrue among the several cities and towns within the state ratably on  
17 the basis of the population last determined by the office of financial  
18 management.

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
