1 BE IT RESOLVED, By the House of Representatives of the State of 2 Washington, the Senate concurring, That the following be adopted:

Convening Special Legislative Sessions

4 The legislature may convene a special legislative session as 5 follows:

6 (1) A resolution calling for convening a special legislative 7 session shall set forth the date and time for convening the session, 8 the duration of the session which shall not exceed thirty days, 9 together with the purpose or purposes for which such session is called. 10 Members of the House of Representatives or Senate may present a 11 proposed resolution for the convening of a special legislative session 12 to the Committee on Rules of their respective houses.

(2) The authority to place a resolution convening a special legislative session before the legislature is vested in the Committee on Rules of the House of Representatives and the Committee on Rules of the Senate.

(3) Upon a majority vote of both the Committee on Rules of the
House of Representatives and the Committee on Rules of the Senate in
favor of a resolution convening a special legislative session, a vote

of the House of Representatives and Senate shall be taken on such
 resolution.

3 (4) The Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives and the 4 Secretary of the Senate shall conduct the vote on the resolution by written ballot of the members of their respective houses under such 5 procedures as may be ordered by the Committee on Rules of their house. б The results of such vote shall be transmitted to the members of the 7 8 legislature and shall be a public record and shall be entered upon the 9 journal of the House of Representatives and Senate at the convening of the next legislative session. 10

(5) If two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to each house vote in favor of the resolution, then a special legislative session shall be convened in accordance with the resolution. (Article II, section 12 of the state Constitution.)
