1 TO THE HONORABLE BILL CLINTON, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES, AND
2 TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AND THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF
3 REPRESENTATIVES, AND TO THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
4 UNITED STATES, IN CONGRESS ASSEMBLED:

5 We, your Memorialists, the Senate and House of Representatives of
6 the State of Washington, in legislative session assembled, respectfully
7 represent and petition as follows:

8 WHEREAS, The constitutional role of our military is to protect the
9 life, liberty, and property of United States citizens and to defend our
10 nation against insurrection or foreign invasion; and

11 WHEREAS, The United States is an independent sovereign nation and
12 not a tributary of the United Nations; and

13 WHEREAS, There is a lack of popular support for the establishment
14 of a "new world order" or world sovereignty of any kind either under
15 the United Nations or under any world body in any form of global
16 government; and

17 WHEREAS, Global government would mean the destruction of our
18 Constitution and corruption of the spirit of the Declaration of
19 Independence, our freedom, and our way of life;

20 NOW, THEREFORE, Your Memorialists respectfully urge the United
21 States Congress to cease to appropriate funds for any military activity

1 not authorized by Congress and to not engage in any military activity
2 under the authority of the United Nations or of any world body.

3 BE IT RESOLVED, That copies of this Memorial be immediately
4 transmitted to the Honorable Bill Clinton, President of the United
5 States, the President of the United States Senate, the Speaker of the
6 House of Representatives, and each member of Congress from the State of
7 Washington.
