1 TO THE HONORABLE WILLIAM J. CLINTON, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED 2 STATES, AND TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AND THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE 3 OF REPRESENTATIVES, AND TO THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF 4 THE UNITED STATES, IN CONGRESS ASSEMBLED:

5 We, your Memorialists, the Senate and House of Representatives of 6 the State of Washington, in legislative session assembled, respectfully 7 represent and petition as follows:

8 WHEREAS, Washington State has encountered major damages to 9 roadways, bridges, and rail lines as a result of flooding in early 10 February 1996; and

11 WHEREAS, The damages brought major movement of goods and people 12 throughout the state to a virtual standstill; and

13 WHEREAS, It is in the interest of the state and nation to 14 facilitate free and orderly movement of goods and people; and

WHEREAS, The lack of available federal funding will drastically inhibit the state's ability to restore the orderly movement of people and goods;

NOW, THEREFORE, Your Memorialists respectfully pray that the United States Congress promptly enact funding authorizations to enable repair and reconstruction of the severe damages caused by the recent floods.
