5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 46.08.190 and 1984 c 258 s 136 are each amended to 6 read as follows:

7 Every district and municipal court judge shall have concurrent 8 jurisdiction with superior court judges of the state for all violations 9 of the provisions of this title, except the trial of felony charges on 10 the merits, and may impose any punishment provided therefor.
