1 AN ACT Relating to excise tax exemptions for academic transcripts;
2 adding a new section to chapter 82.04 RCW; adding a new section to
3 chapter 82.08 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 82.12 RCW; and
4 providing an effective date.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

6 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 82.04 RCW
7 to read as follows:

8 This chapter does not apply to amounts received from sales of
9 academic transcripts by educational institutions.

10 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 82.08 RCW
11 to read as follows:

12 The tax levied by RCW 82.08.020 shall not apply to sales of
13 academic transcripts by educational institutions.

14 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** A new section is added to chapter 82.12 RCW
15 to read as follows:

16 The provisions of this chapter shall not apply in respect to the
17 use of academic transcripts.

1 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 4.** This act shall take effect July 1, 1996.
