- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 19.27 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (1) Ammonia refrigeration systems or systems using type A-1
- 7 refrigerants in cold storage warehouses and controlled atmosphere
- 8 storage warehouses used to store fruit or vegetables are not required
- 9 to comply with any requirements of sections 1118 and 1119 of the
- 10 uniform mechanical code, as adopted by the state building code council,
- 11 or sections 6308 and 6309 of the uniform fire code, as adopted by the
- 12 state building code council, or with any requirements of local
- 13 amendments adopted to these sections of the uniform mechanical code and
- 14 uniform fire code.
- 15 (2) The state building code council shall adopt rules consistent
