# State of Washington 54th Legislature 1995 1st Special Session

By Representative Foreman

Read first time 5/23/95.

BE IT RESOLVED, By the House of Representatives of the State of Washington, the Senate concurring, That immediately before adjournment SINE DIE of this 1995 1st special session of the Fifty-fourth Legislature:

5 (1) The Senate shall transmit to the House of Representatives all 6 House bills, House joint resolutions, House concurrent resolutions, and 7 House joint memorials in its possession that have not been passed by 8 the Senate, and upon receipt by the House of Representatives of such 9 measures they shall be assigned to the House Rules Committee for third 10 reading; and

(2) The House of Representatives shall transmit to the Senate all Senate bills, Senate joint resolutions, Senate concurrent resolutions, and Senate joint memorials in its possession that have not been passed by the House of Representatives, and upon receipt by the Senate of such measures they shall be assigned to the Senate Rules Committee for third reading; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Secretary of the Senate and the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives shall retain in their possession and in the status that exists upon the adjournment SINE DIE of the 1995 1st special session of the Fifty-fourth Legislature, all legislative measures including all bills, joint resolutions, concurrent 1 resolutions, and joint memorials that may at that time be in their 2 respective houses and all records, journals, dockets, and other 3 documents pertaining thereto; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That all measures introduced at any special session of the Fifty-fourth Legislature shall be numbered as a continuation of the numbers assigned to measures of the 1995 1st special session of the Fifty-fourth Legislature.
