- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 35.17.270 and 1965 c 7 s 35.17.270 are each amended to 5 read as follows:
- 6 Every signer to a petition submitting a proposed ordinance to the
- 7 commission shall add to his <u>or her</u> signature his <u>or her printed name as</u>
- 8 <u>it appears on the voter registration roles</u>, place of residence giving
- 9 street ((and)), number, and city or town. Any city or town in which
- 10 the citizens have the power of initiative may, by ordinance, impose
- 11 other reasonable requirements for the signing of initiative petitions

to assure the validity of the signatures. The signatures need not all

- 13 be appended to one paper((, but one of the signers on each paper must
- 14 attach thereto an affidavit stating the number of signatures thereon,
- 15 that each signature thereon is a genuine signature of the person whose
- 16 name it purports to be and that the statements therein made are true as
- 17 he believes)).
