1 AN ACT Relating to burglary in the first degree; and amending RCW 2 9A.52.020.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 9A.52.020 and 1975 1st ex.s. c 260 s 9A.52.020 are 5 each amended to read as follows:

6 (1) A person is guilty of burglary in the first degree if, with 7 intent to commit a crime against a person or property therein, he <u>or</u> 8 <u>she</u> enters or remains unlawfully in a dwelling and if, in entering or 9 while in the dwelling or in immediate flight therefrom, the actor or 10 another participant in the crime (a) is armed with a deadly weapon, or 11 (b) assaults any person ((therein)).

(2) Burglary in the first degree is a class A felony.
