- streamlining, and cost-efficiency and shall require the legislature to 8

- 10 (2) The plan prepared under subsection (1) of this section shall be submitted to the legislature by November 1, 1995. 11
- (3) The plan shall include, but not be limited to, the following: 12
- 13 (a) A plan for the transfer of materials, tangible assets, funds,
- 14 and credits from the office of the commissioner of public lands;
- 15 (b) Direction as to whether personnel of the office of the
- commissioner of public lands shall continue their employment under the 16
- 17 governor's reorganization plan; and
- (c) The requirement that the currently elected commissioner of 18

- 3 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** This act shall take effect if the proposed
- 4 amendment to Article III of the state Constitution abolishing the

- 6 is approved and ratified by the voters at the next general election.
- 7 If the proposed amendment is not so approved and ratified, this act is
- 8 void in its entirety.
