- 1 AN ACT Relating to cigarette sales and advertising; and amending
- 2 RCW 70.155.040.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 70.155.040 and 1993 c 507 s 5 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 (1) No person shall sell or permit to be sold cigarettes not in the 7 original unopened package or container to which the stamps required by
- 8 RCW 82.24.060 have been affixed.
- 9 (2) This section does not apply to the sale of loose leaf tobacco
- 10 by a retail business that generates a minimum of sixty percent of
- 11 annual gross sales from the sale of tobacco products.
- 12 (3) All cigarettes sold in the state and taxed under the provisions
- of chapter 82.24 RCW shall be sold in black and white packaging only.
- 14 The packaging shall consist of a white background with only the brand
- 15 name printed in black. The black printed brand name shall be a
- 16 <u>standard print font size of thirty-four points.</u>

- 1 (4) It is unlawful for cigarettes to be advertised on billboards,
- 2 store fronts, newspapers, television, or radio.
