- 1 AN ACT Relating to abandonment of dependent persons; adding a new
- 2 section to chapter 9A.42 RCW; and prescribing penalties.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 9A.42 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (1) A person entrusted with the physical care of a dependent person
- 7 is guilty of criminal abandonment if he or she knowingly fails to
- 8 assist the dependent person by withholding any of the basic necessities
- 9 of life.
- 10 (2) For the purposes of this section:
- 11 (a) "Dependent person" means a person who, because of physical or
- 12 mental disability, or because of extreme advanced age, is dependent
- 13 upon another person to provide the basic necessities of life.
- 14 (b) "Basic necessities of life" means water, food, shelter,
- 15 clothing, and health care.
- 16 (3) Criminal abandonment is a class C felony.
