- 8 hanging by the neck or, at the election of the defendant,)) by
- 9 intravenous injection of a substance or substances in a lethal quantity
- 10 sufficient to cause death and until the defendant is dead, or, at the
- 11 election of the defendant, by hanging by the neck until the defendant
- 12 <u>is dead</u>. In any case, death shall be pronounced by a licensed
