- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 26.04.210 and 1985 c 82 s 5 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 The county auditor, before a marriage license is issued, upon the

payment of a license fee as fixed in RCW 36.18.010 shall require each

- 8 applicant therefor to make and file in ((his)) the auditor's office
- 8 applicant therefor to make and file in $(\frac{his}{s})$ the auditor's office
- 9 upon blanks to be provided by the county for that purpose, an affidavit
