- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that any entity
- 5 holding a gambling license will be adversely affected by the
- 6 introduction into the state of any slot machine, video pull-tab, video
- 7 poker, or other electronic game of chance. The legislature further
- 8 finds that if any federally recognized Indian tribe is authorized the
- 9 use of these devices by federal court judgment or decree, these gaming
- 10 devices should also be made available to any entity holding a gambling
- 11 license.
- 12 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 9.46 RCW
- 13 to read as follows:
- 14 The commission may adopt rules governing the use of gambling
- 15 devices if gambling devices are authorized on Indian or federal lands.
