1 AN ACT Relating to gambling devices; adding a new section to
2 chapter 9.46 RCW; creating a new section; and repealing RCW 9.46.235.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that any entity
5 holding a gambling license will be adversely affected by the
6 introduction into the state of any slot machine, video pull-tab, video
7 poker, or other electronic game of chance. The legislature further
8 finds that if any federally recognized Indian tribe is authorized the
9 use of these devices by federal court judgment or decree, these gaming
10 devices should also be made available to any entity holding a gambling
11 license.

12 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 9.46 RCW
13 to read as follows:

14 The commission may adopt rules governing the use of gambling
15 devices if gambling devices are authorized on Indian or federal lands.

1 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** RCW 9.46.235 and 1994 c 218 s 15, 1987 c 191
2 s 1, & 1977 ex.s. c 165 s 1 are each repealed.
