- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 9.46.0325 and 1987 c 4 s 29 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 The legislature hereby authorizes any person, association or
- organization operating an established business primarily engaged in the
- 8 selling of food or drink for consumption on the premises to conduct
- 9 social card games and to utilize punch boards and pull-tabs as a
- 10 commercial stimulant to such business when licensed and utilized or
- 11 operated pursuant to the provisions of this chapter and rules and
- 12 regulations adopted pursuant thereto. <u>Punch board or pull-tab devices</u>
- operated in bowling alleys or other establishments frequented by children must be placed out of the direct sight of children visiting
- 15 the establishments.
