- 1 AN ACT Relating to population determinations and projections by the
- 2 office of financial management; and amending RCW 43.62.035.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 43.62.035 and 1991 sp.s. c 32 s 30 are each amended to 5 read as follows:
- 6 The office of financial management shall determine the population
- 7 of each county of the state annually as of April 1st of each year and
- 8 on or before July 1st of each year shall file a certificate with the
- 9 secretary of state showing its determination of the population for each
- 10 county. The office of financial management also shall determine the
- 11 percentage increase in population for each county over the preceding
- 12 ten-year period, as of April 1st, and shall file a certificate with the
- 13 secretary of state by July 1st showing its determination. At least
- 14 once every ten years the office of financial management shall prepare
- 15 twenty-year growth management planning population projections required
- 16 by RCW 36.70A.110 for each county that adopts a comprehensive plan
- 17 under RCW 36.70A.040 and shall review these projections with such
- 18 counties and the cities in those counties before final adoption. Each
- 19 projection may be expressed as a range, the median of which shall

- 1 represent the office's estimate of the most likely population
- 2 projection for the county. The higher end of the range shall not
- 3 <u>exceed one hundred twenty percent of the lower end of the range. If</u>
- 4 any city or county believes that a projection does not accurately
- 5 reflect actual population growth in a county, it may petition the
- 6 office to revise the projection accordingly.
