- 2 and amending RCW 90.58.320.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 90.58.320 and 1971 ex.s. c 286 s 32 are each amended 5 to read as follows:
- (1) No permit shall be issued pursuant to this chapter for any new or expanded building or structure of more than thirty-five feet above average grade level on shorelines of the state that will obstruct the
- 9 view of a substantial number of residences on areas adjoining such 10 shorelines except where a master program does not prohibit the same and
- then only when overriding considerations of the public interest will be
- 12 served.
- 13 (2) A person shall not install or cause to be installed on property
- 14 <u>used for residential or commercial purposes on shorelines any</u>
- 15 ornamental vegetation that will significantly obstruct or restrict the
- 16 view from existing residences on areas adjoining such shorelines. For
- 17 purposes of this subsection, ornamental vegetation includes any type of
- 18 plant introduced to the site by the owner or the owner's agent, except
- 19 <u>vegetation introduced pursuant to a requirement for environmental</u>

- 1 <u>mitigation or remediation. Local government may include provisions in</u>
- 2 <u>master programs establishing appropriate height and bulk standards for</u>
- 3 <u>ornamental vegetation in residential and commercial areas of the</u>

- 5 Where such provisions have been adopted they shall be deemed to provide
- 6 compliance with this subsection. This subsection does not apply to
- 7 <u>areas managed for open space, forestry, or agricultural purposes.</u>
