- The department shall preserve, protect, perpetuate and manage the food fish and shellfish in state waters and offshore waters.
- 8 The department shall conserve the food fish and shellfish resources
- 9 in a manner that does not impair the resource. In a manner consistent
- 10 with this goal, the department shall seek to maintain the economic
- 11 well-being and stability of the fishing industry in the state. The
- 12 department shall promote orderly fisheries and shall enhance and
